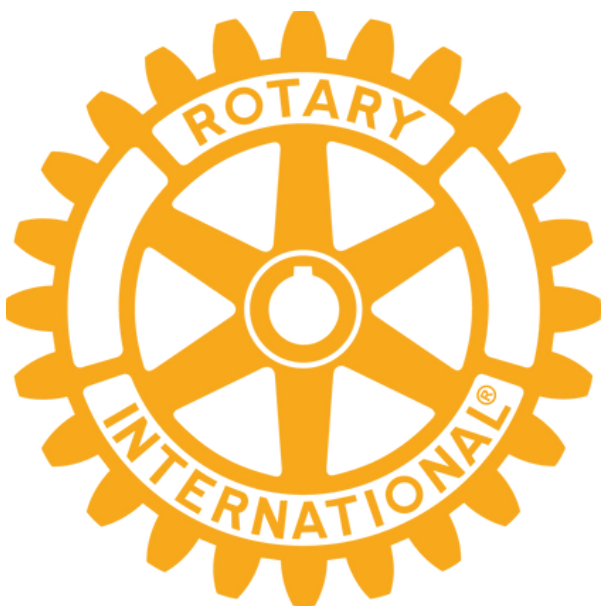

## Queensland's Flying Obstetrician

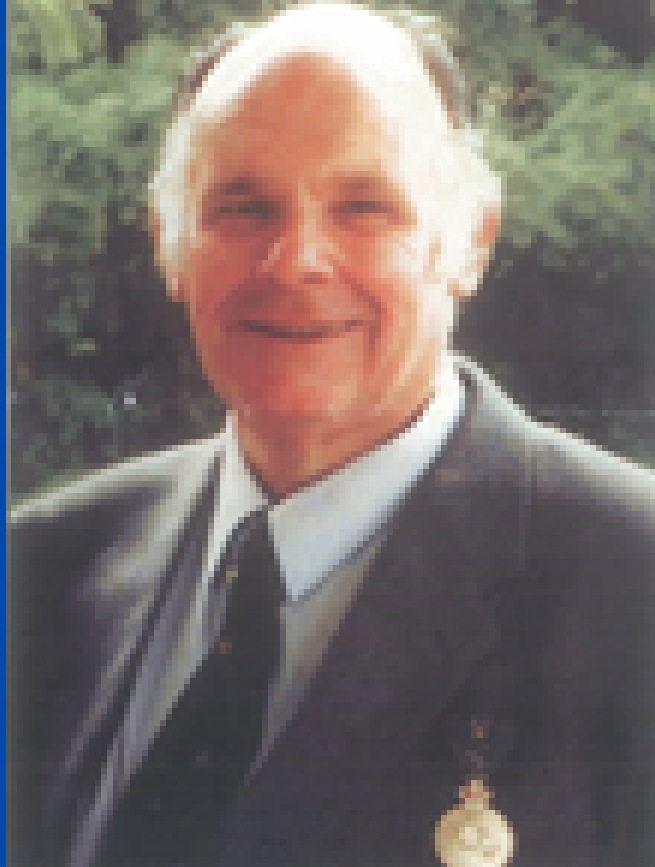
Dr Jim Baker was the creator of Queensland's flying obstetrician and gynecologist service and revolutionized the delivery of health services in rural Queensland.

He was also a founding and life member of the Livestock Transport Association of Queensland.

Throughout his life and throughout his membership of our club, Jim had a particular interest in a high level of vocational service, both as an ideal and as a working ethic.

"Vocational Service" is serving others through the workplace, aspiring to achieve high ethical standards, aiming to share skills and expertise through vocations, and inspiring others in the process.

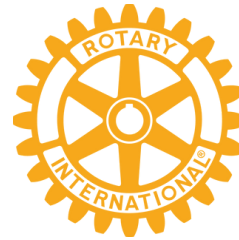
